

## Let's Talk: Day 8

Today's Reading: John 6:25-40

Share a sandwich while discussing who is the true "Bread of Life."  
Name your favorite bread or other carb!

Questions:

1. What does Jesus say He is?
2. Who gave Jesus power, and who sent Him to earth?
3. Brainstorm similarities between what bread does for us physically and what the Bread of Life does for us spiritually?
4. Think of a time you were just "starving" for food. Have you ever had a similar time when you craved Jesus? Explain. If not, why not?

## Let's Talk: Day 9

Today's Reading: John 7:10-36

Talk about a time when someone may have said something that was mean or wasn't true. Jesus had many enemies that made rude and mean comments to Him that weren't true.

Questions:

1. What does Jesus say He gets from His Father?
2. Jesus tells them that He will be with them and then He will be gone. Where will He go?
3. Why do you think these people were mean to Jesus and did not believe what He was saying?
4. How can you seek Jesus and have Him be part of your life?

## Let's Talk: Day 10

Today's Reading: John 8:23-32

Play the game “two truths and a lie” about something that happened today (this is where you tell two things that did happen and one that didn’t). Can the other family members correctly guess which one is the lie? Was it easier to tell the truth or the lie? Reaffirm that God’s Word is always true. Everything He says is trustworthy.

Questions:

1. Where is Jesus from?
2. What will make us free? What do you think enslaves us? Have you ever told, or do you know someone else that has told, a lie and then chose to continue to cover it up? Is that person free?
3. How do you feel when people tell you the truth? How do you feel when people lie to you?

## **Let’s Talk: Day 11**

Today’s Reading: John 9:1-34

Have your child close their eyes and lead them around the room. If you feel it is safe you can let them walk around by themselves. Talk about what it would be like to go through life blind.

Questions:

1. How did Jesus heal the blind man?
2. When did Jesus heal the blind man?
3. On what day is the Sabbath of the Old Testament?
4. Would you be willing to stand up to others who questioned Jesus and His actions? If you have done so, discuss the situation?

## **Let’s Talk: Day 12**

Today’s Reading: John 10:22-39

To introduce the idea of recognizing voices, use your computer to look up different characters. Then have your kids turn their back as you play the voice and have them guess the character. Some ideas: SpongeBob:

Questions:

1. What does Jesus compare us to as His believers?
2. Do you know God's voice as well as you recognize your parents' voices or the voices of popular TV / movie characters? How did you learn the voices of your family? How can you learn to recognize God's voice too?
3. What does it mean that Jesus has given us "eternal life?"

### **Let's Talk: Day 13**

Today's Reading: Exodus 16:1-5

Today's passage is a reference from our John 6 reading earlier in the month. Make a list of 3 items or draw 3 items that you are thankful for and then praise God (say a prayer) for these items.

Questions:

1. What did God give to the nation of Israel?
2. Just a few chapters earlier, God delivered the Israelites from Egypt through a series of plagues, ending with the parting of the Red Sea; however, yet the Israelites were already complaining. Why is that? Think back over the last week: did you spend more time being thankful about situations or complaining about them? How can you grow to be more thankful?
3. How is this story similar to the one we read in John 6? What has God provided for you and your family?

### **Let's Talk: Day 14**

Today's Reading: Today is the weekly OFF day

Suggested Activity:

Work on the memory verse together for the book of John.

*John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.*
