

## Let's Talk: Day 120

Today's Reading: 2Peter 1 / Family Focus: verses 12-21

For some family fun, make a tent with blankets and crawl in it to read the Bible passage for today.

Questions:

1. What things do you know but you still need to be reminded of (your parents can help you with this if you have trouble)? What spiritual things do you need to be reminded of, even though you know them?
2. What did the voice from heaven say to Jesus?
3. Where do we get prophecy?
4. Peter wrote these words. He saw Jesus transfigured before his eyes and heard God speak from heaven, but what did he say was even more reliable than that? If Peter says it is even more reliable than the audible voice of God should we spend time memorizing it? As a family, see how many verses from the Bible you can quote.

## Let's Talk: Day 121

Today's Reading: 2Peter 2 / Family Focus: verses 1-3

Use different voices (British accent, Southern accent, baby voice, deep voice, whisper, etc) to practice a verse you are currently working on memorizing. Regardless of the voice used, the words being said are true and right because they are from God.

Questions:

1. What will the false prophets and false teachers do?
2. How can it happen that many people will follow these lies?
3. What are ways we can test what people tell us about God to help us know whether or not these are false teachers? (think about yesterday's LET'S TALK)

## Let's Talk: Day 122

Today's Reading: 2Peter 3 / Family Focus: verses 8-13

Make an acrostic poem using the words "New Heaven New Earth" and describe what the New Heaven and New Earth will be like. Example N = no crying, E = eternal, and so on.

Questions:

1. What is one day to the Lord like to us?
2. How will the day of the Lord come?
3. Discuss some of the descriptive words you wrote in your poem. Heaven will be a hundred times better than anyone could ever imagine. Talk about what heaven may look like.
4. We have been waiting for Jesus to come back for almost 2,000 years (two days on God's timeline). Some people doubt that it will ever happen. How does verse nine explain one of God's reasons for waiting?

## Let's Talk: Day 123

Today's Reading: Romans 1 / Family Focus: verses 16-20

Each of you mold something that is God's creation. God's voice speaks not only in his written Word but in all the details of His creation. What do you hear?

Questions:

1. What will the just live by?
2. How has God made His existence known to all?
3. Considering all of God's creation what do you think is: the most beautiful? Detailed? Silliest? Most disgusting?
4. What are some ways God has revealed Himself to you either through events, miracles, prayers, other people, creation, etc?

## Let's Talk: Day 124

Today's Reading: Romans 2 / Family Focus: verses 1-3

Today's section will talk about judging. Discuss as a family how the legal system works in our country. Do your kids know about everyone's right to a fair and speedy trial? Do they know how a jury works? After this discussion, read this Bible passage to see what it says about judging.

Questions:

1. When we judge others, what are we doing to our self? Who is the only true Judge?
2. Someday we, as Christians, will have to judge the world and angels (read 1Corinthians 6:2&3), so this passage isn't saying judging is wrong. The key verse is actually in verse 11. Do you judge according to God's impartial standard or do you play favorites? Do you judge yourself less harshly than the world?
3. Have you ever had thoughts about someone before you got to know them?
4. Has someone else ever judged you based on what you look like or what you have said? Did they judge you but then judge someone else completely differently? How did that make you feel?

### **Let's Talk: Day 125**

Today's Reading: Psalm 19 / Family Focus: verses 1-4

Questions:

1. Who declares the glory of God?
2. Where have the words gone out to?
3. What is your favorite part of God's creation? What makes you go "wow" the most?

### **Let's Talk: Day 126**

Today's Reading: Today is the weekly OFF day

Mystery Question for the upcoming week: What declares the glory of God?
