

Let's Talk: Day 99-Whole Bible

Today's Reading: Joshua 3-4, Psalms 131-135 / Family Chapter:
Joshua 4

Think of an amazing miracle God has done for your family. Make your own "altar of remembrance" for your home, one stone for each member.

Questions:

1. What did the 12 men build on the other side of Jordan? Why did they build it?
2. What happened when the priests finished crossing the Jordan and their feet touched dry land?
3. What would you have thought if you were one of the Israelites in this chapter?
4. What "stones" do you personally have that you can look back on and know God was working in your life?

Let's Talk: Day 100

Today's Reading: Joshua 5-6, Psalms 136-138 / Family Chapter:
Joshua 6

Can you think of other times the number "7" is used in the bible? Can you do 7 push-ups? 7 sit-ups? March around the table 7 times or act out this whole chapter with family members and/or stuffed animals.

Questions:

1. What did the people need to do for six days? Who led them?
2. What couldn't the people do these six days? What would you have been thinking?
3. What did they all do differently on the seventh day?
4. It sounded crazy, but the people followed God's instructions and won a great victory. How might God be asking you to follow His direction for your life?

Let's Talk: Day 101

Today's Reading: Joshua 7-9, Psalms 139-140 / Family Chapter: Psalm 139

Take turns naming something that God knows about you that you don't even know.

Questions:

1. Where can you go to get away from God?
2. What does God know about your thoughts? How does that make you feel?
3. While you were still growing inside your mother, what did God know about your future?
4. What does the psalmist think about God's thoughts? What do you think about God's thoughts? What is something that God thinks?

Let's Talk: Day 102

Today's Reading: Joshua 10-11, Psalms 141-144 / Family Chapter: Joshua 10

Challenge a family member to a thumb war. Let the winner GENTLY place his/her foot on the loser's neck to show victory or do a victory dance. Do this five times.

Questions:

1. What miracles happened in this chapter?
2. How did most of the enemy die in verses 7-11? What does that tell you about God's care for His people?
3. What happened to the five kings that tried to destroy God's people?
4. Does anything or anyone stand a chance against God? How can your life show that you believe that?

Let's Talk: Day 103

Today's Reading: Joshua 12-14, Psalms 145-146 / Family Chapter: Psalm 146

See if you can give a reason to praise God for each letter of the alphabet, from A-Z. Also check out “Undignified” on Youtube: <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UV6fNwOzvG8>. How can you get over feeling too “dignified” to praise God?

Questions:

1. Who does the psalmist say is happy? Why?
2. In what things do you put your trust? How can you trust in God more?
3. What are some of the things that God does according to this psalm? Have you ever praised God for any of these things before? If so, what?
4. What does the last verse of the psalm mean to you?

Let's Talk: Day 104

Today's Reading: Joshua 15-16, Psalms 147-148 / Family Chapter: Psalm 148

Act out or draw something mentioned in the psalm that praises God.

Questions:

1. How can nature praise God?
2. What piece of God's creation makes you think about God the most? Why?
3. Who do you know that has a life that just gives God glory? What is it about them that shows you this?
4. God's name alone is exalted. Does that seem true in today's society? What do you think that verse means?

Let's Talk: Day 105

Today's Reading: Today is the weekly OFF day

Mystery Question for the upcoming week: How old was Joshua when he died? Joshua 24

In a few different readings over the last several days we have heard God tell His people to be “strong and courageous” and to “trust in the Lord.” Have one member of the family draw a picture of the walls of

Jericho. Then have each member write something on those walls that they are trusting God for deliverance or victory. Put it on your fridge and pray about those items for the next week. Encourage each other to trust God and be courageous!
