Look for this:

- **Rev 18:** Why God's people were supposed to leave Babylon
- **Rev 19:** The names of the white horse rider (i.e. Jesus' names)
- **Rev 20:** How many years Christ is to reign on earth
- **Rev 21:** What there will be no more of someday
- **Rev 22:** The last prayer in the Bible
- **Isaiah 65:** Compare Isa 65:17 to Rev 21:1

Tips:

- This section is the highlight of Christianity. It portrays Christ for who He really is – the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords!
- Here we see the reunion (Marriage Supper of the Lamb), the return of Christ (Rev 19:11), the reign of Christ on the earth for 1,000 years (Rev 20:1-10), the rerun of earth's final battle (20:7-10), the great white throne judgment (20:11-15), and finally, the new heaven and earth (21-22).
- The end times drama hits a crescendo in these final chapters of Revelation as we see two realities: Jesus is Coming and We Win!
