Look for this:

- **Mark 2:** What the four men did to get their friend to Jesus
- **Mark 3:** Who Jesus said were His mother, brother, and sister
- **Mark 4:** What Jesus did to calm the stormy sea
- **Mark 5:** How people reacted to Jesus healing the demoniac
- **Mark 6:** What role the disciples had in feeding the 5,000
- **1Samuel 21:** Compare 1Sam 21 to Mark 2:25-26

Tips:

- The gospel of Mark presents Jesus as the Perfect Servant. The gospel does not start with Jesus' genealogy or birth. Instead it jumps immediately into the ministry of John the Baptist and the service of Jesus. Mark dispenses with Jesus' divine titles, includes less of Jesus' messages, and focuses on what Jesus did.
- Notice the key words "immediately" and "then" throughout the Gospel of Mark. They communicate Mark's desire to move quickly in describing Jesus' actions. Remember, as the Perfect Servant, Jesus was a **doer**, not just a talker.
