Look for this:

- 1Cor 12: How God gives spiritual gifts so we can help others
- 1Cor 13: What is more important than anything we say or do
- 1Cor 14: How an orderly service helps unbelievers follow God
- 1Cor 15: What is implied if Christ is not risen from the dead
- 1Cor 16: How often the people were to give their offerings
- Isa 25: Compare Isaiah 25:8 to 1Corinthians 15:52-54

Tips:

- The Corinthian Church was misusing the spiritual gifts God gave them. It was harming the church body. Paul said we should view every gift and ability as a conduit of God's love (1Cor 12-14).
- In 1Corinthians 15, Paul gives the most extensive explanation of resurrection in the Bible. He identifies several witnesses of Christ's resurrection, explains the theological implications of Christ's resurrection, and describes human resurrection.
- Isaiah 25 describes the strength of the Lord.
