Tips:

- In the final chapters of 2Corinthians, Paul defends his ministry against false apostles.
- The book of Luke is the first of a 2-part series. The book of Acts is the second part. The book of Luke deals with the humanity of Christ as the Son of Man.
- Luke was a medical doctor [Col 4:14]. He was precise in his accounts and testimony of the events of Christ. Five of the six miracles in Luke are healing miracles.
- Luke was the only gospel writer who wasn't a Jew. He was a Gentile.

- Luke 1-3 tells of the birth and early years of Jesus.
