Look for this:

- **Luke 3:** What people heard when Jesus was baptized
- **Luke 4:** How Satan tempted Jesus in three ways
- **Luke 5:** What Peter said after the miraculous catch of fish
- **Luke 6:** Why Jesus was criticized for healing the man's hand
- **Luke 7:** What amazed Jesus about the faith of the centurion
- **Isaiah 40:** Compare Isaiah 40:3 to Luke 3:4

Tips:

- Luke (author of Luke and Acts) may have been a Gentile (Col 4:14) and the only non-Jewish author in the New Testament.
- Luke's themes include: Gentiles, women, prayer, Holy Spirit, human sinfulness, and salvation.
- Luke 3 gives Jesus' age at baptism and His genealogy. The genealogy goes back to Adam through Mary's side of the family and calls out the aspect of Christ as man.
