Look for this:

- **Luke 13:** Why the ruler was hypocritical to criticize a healing
- **Luke 14:** What Jesus required of people to be His disciples
- **Luke 15:** What happens in heaven when one sinner repents
- **Luke 16:** What the rich man remembered about his life
- **Luke 17:** What percentage of the lepers thanked Jesus
- **Deuteronomy:** Compare Deuteronomy 15:7 to Luke 16:20

Tips:

- Luke tells of the controversy between the Pharisees and Jesus when He shows compassion on the Sabbath (Luke 13:10-17).
- Look for two recurring themes in the conflict with the Pharisees: their attitude toward the lost and their attitude toward money.
- In this section, Jesus outlines the heartbeat of His Heavenly Father, as well as describing His singular mission, “to seek and save that which was lost.”
- Notice Jesus’ speaking technique: using parables. He chose this method of storytelling to illustrate points to those who were

receptive and to hide the truth from those whose hearts were calloused.
