Look for this:

- **Luke 21:** How God evaluates giving based upon percentage
- **Luke 22:** Why Jesus asked the disciples to pray
- **Isaiah 56:** Compare Isaiah 56:7 to Luke 19:46

Tips:

- Notice the human side of Jesus as He weeps over Jerusalem in Luke 19 and experiences agony in Luke 22.
- Notice the key verse:
Luke 19:10 for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost. (NKJV)
