Look for this:

- Acts 18: Who Apollos followed before learning about Jesus
- Amos 9: Compare Amos 9:11-12 to Acts 15:16-17

Tips:

- Acts 15 records how the church resolved the early tension between Jewish-background and Gentile-background believers. The question was: Can a Gentile become a Christian without also converting to Judaism and keeping the Law of Moses?
- Acts 16:8-11 records a key moment in history when missionaries took the good news of Jesus from Asia to Europe.
- The focus begins to change from Jesus as Israel's Messiah to Christ as the world's Savior.
