Look for this:

- **Acts 19:** Why Demetrius opposed Paul at Ephesus
- **Acts 20:** What Paul said would build up the church at Ephesus
- **Acts 21:** What Paul said about facing arrest in Jerusalem
- **Acts 22:** What Paul said to send the crowd into a rage
- **Acts 23:** How Paul divided the council who questioned him
- **Ezekiel 33:** Compare Ezekiel 33:1-6 to Acts 20:26-27

Tips:

- Paul received several warnings about going to Jerusalem (Acts 21:10-14); however, he was determined to go as God directed regardless of the warnings. He was resolute in his calling.
- Notice the division that Christianity sets. There were uproars, mobs, rallies, and mass confusion against this new movement.
- The outcry against Paul (Acts 22:22) marked the Jewish dispersion rejecting the offer of the kingdom and their outrage that Paul said the Gentiles would have a part in salvation.
