Look for this:

- **Acts 25:** Why Festus offered to transfer Paul to Jerusalem
- **Acts 26:** How King Agrippa responded to Paul's speech
- **Acts 27:** How hope was lost on the ship during the storm
- **Acts 28:** What Paul's life in Rome was like
- **Isaiah 26:** Compare Isaiah 26:19 to Acts 24:14-15

Tips:

- While in prison, Paul wrote Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, Philemon, and Galatians.
- Paul tried one last time (Acts 28:28) to testify to the Jews about the kingdom of God.
- The book of Acts ends with Paul in prison, ministering in Rome; however, the ongoing story of Acts is being "written" to this day as the church lifts up Jesus and shares His Word with the world.
