Look for this:

- **Galatians 5:** How we are to use our liberty/freedom from the law

Tips:

- The book of Galatians is Paul's letter to churches in what we know as modern Turkey. Paul was confronting legalism (attempting to please God by rules, rituals, and obedience instead of by grace and faith). False teachers were spreading legalism [Gal 1:9, 3:1, 6:12], perverting the gospel message [1:7], creating hypocrites [2:11-13], cursing people with trying to keep the law [3:10], and destroying their spiritual lives [5:1].
- Galatians is about standing in the liberty of Christ.
