### Look for this:

### Tips:

- Paul established the Ephesian church (Acts 18-20). The book of Ephesians is Paul's letter to that church. Paul wrote to reveal the mystery of the church as Christ's body (Eph 3:2-6).
- Notice the major shift in topics from riches in Christ to our walk in Christ. Ephesians 1-3 reveals truths about our riches in Christ. Ephesians 4-6 contains practical applications for our daily walk in Christ.
