Look for this:

- **Philippians 4:** Why Paul believed He had the strength to do anything
- **Colossians 1:** Why we are to proclaim and teach Christ to everyone
- **Colossians 2:** What Jesus did to Old Testament Law at the cross
- **Colossians 3:** How we are to interact with the Word of God
- **Colossians 4:** What Epaphras was praying for the church in Corinth
- **Psalms 33:** Compare Psalm 33:1 to Philippians 4:4

Tips:

- The book of Colossians is Paul's letter to a church he had not visited (Col 2:1). Paul wrote because they were drifting away from the truth of the gospel (Col 1:23, Col 2:4, 8) and were no longer finding Christ sufficient (Col 1:19, Col 2:9-10).
- The book begins with doctrinal truths (Col 1-2) and ends with practical applications (Col 3-4).
- Colossians focuses on the preeminence and deity of Christ.
