Tips:

- In Paul's second letter to the Thessalonians, he clears up their confused thinking about Christ's Second Coming.
- The book of Hebrews is a New Testament guide to the Old Testament. It proves Jesus is better. He is better than angels. He is a better priest and sacrifice. He offers a better covenant.
- The book of Hebrews is a letter designed to show Jews how Christ fulfilled and replaced the Old Covenant with a better one.
- We are not told who the author of Hebrews was. Some say it was either Paul or Apollos.
