### Look for this:

- **Matthew 19:** Who finds it difficult to enter God's kingdom
- **Matthew 20:** How natural and Christ-like leadership styles differ
- **Matthew 21:** What Israel's rejection of Jesus meant to Gentiles
- **Matthew 22:** What Jesus said was the greatest commandment
- **Matthew 23:** Whether people are cleansed outside or inside first
- **Deuteronomy 6:** Compare Deuteronomy 6:5 to Matthew 22:37-38

### Tips:

- Jesus often quoted Hebrew Scriptures. Find references to Genesis in Matthew 19; to Exodus, Leviticus, Deuteronomy in Matthew 22; and to Jeremiah in Matthew 21.
- At the beginning of Matthew 19, Jesus left Galilee and traveled to Judea. In Matthew 21, He entered Jerusalem and clashed with His enemies [Mat 21-23].
