

Tips:

- Notice what happens when Abraham and Sarah take a detour rather than waiting for God to fulfill His promises, in His way, in His own time. Keep a note of this for those times when you are tempted to rely on your own wisdom.
- When we trust Christ to save us and agree that He is our Lord, the Holy Spirit performs a spiritual circumcision on us.
- As you read the story of Abraham and Sarah, consider your own faith journey. Have you noticed that along with His promises come tests? Everything you do is important to Him.
