

Tips:

- Some of the ways Joseph pictures Christ are that he was beloved of his father, hated by his brothers, falsely accused, unjustly punished and finally elevated to a powerful throne.
- Consider how long Joseph waited before he identified himself to his brothers. True reconciliation requires real repentance. This may not happen immediately. Joseph waited to be sure.
- Notice the change in Judah from being the one to sell Joseph into slavery to being the one to offer his own life for Benjamin.
