

Tips:

- Moses warned the people that prosperity could tempt them to become proud and forget God. Consider whether you seek God more when you are experiencing a trial or when things appear to be going well for you. How faithful are you to God?
- A key theme in Joshua is claiming our victory and inheritance in Christ. The name Joshua is the Hebrew form of Jesus. Joshua served as Moses' assistant. The key to Joshua's victories was not his skill. It was his submission to the Word of God [**Josh 1:8**].
