

Tips:

- Discouragement over the past and fear of the future chip away at our faith similar to what Israel experienced. The only solution is to read (hear) and believe God’s Word. How often you take in God’s Word? Is it enough to keep your faith strong?
- Even when you think you know the best solution to a problem, ask God how He wants you to handle things. Consider how much trouble Israel would have avoided if they had asked God before making an agreement with the Gibeonites.
