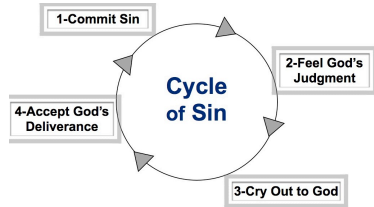


Tips:
