

**Tips:**

- When the Assyrians conquered northern Israel (Samaria), a remnant remained who intermarried with other exiles. This led to worship of foreign gods. The Samaritans adapted and perverted the Jewish faith. In the days of Christ, there was open hatred between Jews and Samaritans.
- The name Hezekiah means “the Lord strengthens.” He reigned for 29 years and aimed to please God. He pointed the people back to worshipping God and away from idols.
