

Tips:

- Between Acts 8 and Acts 12, you can see the expansion of the church in Jerusalem that occurs when God brings trials to move them out of their comfort zone.
- Throughout the book of Acts, look for transitions (Judaism > Christianity, Law > Grace, Works > Faith, Ruler > Redeemer).
- In the early Church, there were some who thought you must become a Jew to become a Christian. The issues they worked through were that salvation is not by works and that God had made salvation open to all believers.
