**Tips:**

- The life of Joseph contains many prophetic parallels to Jesus including: special love of the father, predicting his future reign, betrayal by his family, not being recognized at his first visit with his family, revealing his true identity during his second visit, delivering the ones who betrayed him, and offering forgiveness.
- Job is filled with rich prophetic pictures (i.e. types) which foreshadow the coming Messiah and His suffering. Notice some of the prophetic details in Job 30:
  - ▶ Being mocked and spat upon by an angry mob
  - ▶ Seeing his instrument of destruction being raised
  - ▶ Praying to God but hearing no answer
  - ▶ Being lifted up to the wind
  - ▶ Weeping for those in trouble
  - ▶ Suffering with burning pain
