- Psalm 22 is one of the greatest prophecies about Christ's crucifixion. Christ quoted verse one when he was on the cross (Mark 15:34). Many other verses are fulfilled including verse two (Mark 15:33), verse 15 (John 19:28), and verses 16 and 18 (Mark 15:24). Can you find other similarities?
