**Tips:**

- Israel’s conquest of the “Promised Land” pictures our growth in God’s “Promises” (Heb 3-4). Israel defeated a central city (Jericho), learned about sin (Ai) and gullibility (Gibeon), took the south and north, and ensured all tribes inherited their land.
- Psalms 145-150 are the final group of “Hallelujah Psalms,” each of which begin with the phrase “Praise the Lord.” In Hebrew, “Hallelu” is the word for “praise” and “Jah” is the covenant name for God (see Exo 3:13-15, 6:2-4).
- Psalms 111-113 are more “Hallelujah Psalms.”

- 100. What unusual plan God made to overthrow Jericho (Josh 6); What phrase is repeated 26 times in praise (Psa 136)

102. What miracle God did to overcome the Amorites (Josh 10); Who is truly innocent or righteous before God (Psa 143)
103. How Caleb's confidence in God did not waver (Josh 14); Why it is unwise to place your trust in people (Psa 146)
104. How a husband interceded for his bride to the father (Josh 15); Why people should praise the Lord (Psa 148)
