Tips:

- The books of 2Chronicles records Israel’s tragic slide from their pinnacle under King Solomon and the building of the temple, to their apostasy, defeat, and exile under subsequent kings.
- The gospel of Luke presents Jesus as the Son of man. Luke was a physician (Col 4:14) who recorded details about Jesus’ humanity including:
 - ▶ His birth, circumcision, and childhood (Luke 2)
 - ▶ His age at baptism and genealogy (Luke 3)
- Consider how the genealogies differ in Matthew and Luke

Look for this:

- 200. What happened when Solomon finished praying (2Chr 7); What Peter said after the miraculous catch of fish (Luke 5)
- 201. Why Shishak, King of Egypt, invaded from the south (2Chr 12); Why Jesus was criticized for healing the man's hand (Luke 6)
- 202. Why Asa removed his relative as "queen mother" (2Chr 15); What surprised Jesus about the faith of the centurion (Luke 7)
