Tips:

- 2Chronicles attributes Judah’s military losses to God’s intentional, disciplinary action.

Rehoboam	Lord left you in...hand of Shishak	12:5
Jehoram	Lord stirred up...the Philistines	21:16
Ahaz	Lord brought Judah low	28:19
Manasseh	Lord brought...king of Assyria	33:11
Zedekiah	He brought...king of...Chaldeans	36:17
