Tips:

- After the fall of Jerusalem, most Jews were exiled to Babylon. God commanded both the exiles and remnant left behind to submit to Babylon; however, leader led the remnant to flee to Egypt for protection. This pictures how people flee to the world system instead of God for support.
- In 1Corinthians, Paul addresses a host of major problems in the church. These included: arrogance, denial of key doctrines, misuse of spiritual gifts, and openly sinful lifestyles. For each issue, Paul counsels them on its biblical solution.
