Tips:

- The book of Ezekiel is organized into four parts:
 - ▶ Ezekiel 1-3 gives Ezekiel's vision and calling.
 - ▶ Ezekiel 4-24 gives God's warnings to Jerusalem before its fall.
 - ▶ Ezekiel 25-39 contains prophecies against various Gentile nations.
 - ▶ Ezekiel 40-48 envisions a future temple and city that God blesses.
- Ezekiel opens with a vision of "cherubim," mighty spiritual beings connected with the throne of God.
- The book of Galatians is Paul's letter to churches in what we know as modern Turkey. Paul was confronting the legalism that false teachers were spreading.
