Tips:

- Ezekiel 40-48 records a vision of a perfect Jewish temple which inspired the Jews in exile and convicted them of their sins (Eze 43:6-12). This temple differed from the First and Second Temples. Many scholars believe it is the temple of the thousand year reign of Jesus Christ in the Millennium (Rev 20:1-10).
- Daniel was a boy of high rank who was taken to Babylon in the first wave of exiles. He spent his life in the luxurious royal court.
- The book of 2Timothy is Paul's final letter. He faced death in prison (2Tim 1:2, 4:6-8). Paul wanted Timothy to endure suffering and hardship in ministry (2Tim 1:4-12, 2:1-3, 3:12) and remain a faithful minister of God's word (2Tim 1:13, 2:15, 3:15-16, 4:2-3).
- The book of Titus is Paul's letter to a Greek disciple (Gal 2:3) he left on the island of Crete to identify and train local pastors (Titus 1:5-13). Its theme is maintaining good works (Titus 1:16, 2:14, 3:8).
- The book of Philemon is Paul's letter from jail on behalf of a servant named Onesimus who had wronged his master and escaped. Paul urged Philemon to forgive him and accept him back as more than a servant – as a beloved brother in Christ.

- The book of Hebrews is a letter designed to show Jews how Christ fulfilled and replaced the Old Covenant with a better one.
