**Tips:**

- Daniel recorded many prophecies about the future of empires (Babylon, Media-Persia, Greece, and Rome). His prophecies were so accurate that scholars who deny the supernatural are forced to claim it was written well after the events happened.
- Many of Daniel’s prophecies have yet to occur. Jesus quoted Daniel many times including the abomination of desolation (Mat 24:15; Dan 9:27; 11:31, 12:11), His second coming as “Son of Man” (Mat 10:23, 16:27-28; Dan 7:13), and the resurrection (Mat 13:43, Dan 12:3). Daniel is the Old Testament companion to the book of Revelation.
- The book of Hebrews is a New Testament guide to the Old Testament. It proves Jesus is better. He is better than angels. He is a better priest and sacrifice. He offers a better covenant.
