Malachi 3:1

Read Mark 1:1-8 and Malachi 3:1.

Questions

1. If you were the messenger that God chose, what would you tell others about Jesus? What holds you back from saying it to those around you?
2. Who is the messenger that Malachi mentions?
3. Not only was Jesus prophesied about hundreds of years before He came to earth, John's job was also foretold. Do you think John knew and understood about his role in declaring the name of Jesus?
4. How did John prepare the way for Jesus?

Bonus question

Explain the family relationship between Jesus and John the Baptist.

Malachi 4

Draw a picture or describe what you think it will be like when Jesus returns to earth. Jesus will come back with all believers to reign as the rightful king. How do you think you will feel when Jesus returns?

Questions

1. What name is Jesus called in this passage? Why do you think God uses that image to describe Jesus?
2. Who will be sent to us?
3. How will we know when Jesus is going to return to earth?
4. As believers we have nothing to fear. How can you comfort others about Jesus' return?
