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## Revelation: Let's Talk

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This Grace@Home Let's Talk Guide provides discussion questions and activities that you may use to facilitate conversations about God and His Word in your home. The focus is on those chapters that are most likely to promote meaningful conversations for all ages of family members.

### Revelation 1

Draw a picture of the vision John had of Jesus.  
Or, you could have a competition to see who can find out the fastest how many times the word "seven" is mentioned in the Bible.

#### Questions

1. What are all the "seven"s you can find in this chapter?
2. Where should we look when Jesus comes back?
3. What does Jesus say in verse eight? What does this mean to you?
4. What do the seven stars represent? What about the seven lamp stands? Do you think your local church might have a representative angel?

### Revelation 3

In what way could God describe a wealthy person as "poor, blind, and naked"? Poor in what? Blind to what? Unclothed in what?

#### Questions

1. What is wrong with the church of Sardis? What are they supposed to do?
2. What is right with the church of Philadelphia?
3. What is wrong with the church of Laodicea? How have they deceived themselves?
4. What church do you most closely identify with? Is the door to your heart open to Jesus? How do you know? Pray to Him and He promises to come in.

## Revelation 5

Listen to "The Revelation Song" on either [youtube.com](https://www.youtube.com) or [godtube.com](https://www.godtube.com).

### Questions

1. What needed to be opened and who opened it?
2. Do you think all the songs will be sung separately or together? Do you think they will sing in harmony or unison? Why?
3. Which of the lyrics to these songs touch you most and why?
4. Someday all Christ followers will be witness to the scene in this chapter. What do you imagine you will feel that day? Where in the crowd would you want to stand?

## Revelation 7

What hope does verse 15 give you? What job do you hope to do?

### Questions

1. What will the four angels stop? What effect will that have on the earth?
2. How many people will be sealed?
3. Who are the people clothed in white robes? What will their job be?
4. What amazes you most about this chapter? Do you believe this will all happen one day?

## Revelation 10

Draw a picture of the mighty angel described in this chapter.

### Questions

1. What was the angel holding?
2. What did John do with it?
3. What happened when the angel spoke? What did John try to do and was told not to?
4. Chapters like this can leave us a little confused. John is talking about a time that has not yet happened. What can you do when you read a passage like this in the Bible and have a hard time completely understanding it or applying it to your life?

## Revelation 11

The two witnesses are given four superpowers. What is the purpose in giving them those powers? If you were them, which of the powers would you use the most? Why?

### Questions

1. How are the two witnesses described? Some wonder if these are the two Old Testament characters of Moses and Elijah. Why would they say that?
2. What will happen to these two witnesses?
3. It sounds like science fiction stories, but these events will actually happen someday. How can you imagine this story being reported on the news?
4. Verses 15-19 give God's perspective from heaven and remind us of His power. No matter what craziness is occurring on earth, God has it all under control. What acknowledgement of His power and praise could you offer Him today?

## Revelation 14

Ask each person to complete this sentence (from verse 7) but personalize it to what God means to you: "Worship Him who \_\_\_\_\_."

### Questions

1. Who sang a new song around the throne of heaven? As you have read the last few days, how noisy do you think it is in heaven?
2. Angels are God's messengers. How do you see them do their job in this chapter?
3. Where is Jesus found in this chapter?
4. What kind of emotions do you feel from this chapter? Do you believe that God is good and just even when you read hard passages like this one?

## Revelation 19

Draw a picture of the rider in this chapter. Label it with the names in verse 11, 13, 16. What is another name you know for Him?

### Questions

1. What are some of the praises coming from heaven in this chapter?
2. Who is involved in the marriage?
3. Describe Jesus as He gets ready to leave heaven. Do you think the hero arriving on a white horse in many books and movies might have originated from this passage?
4. How does the battle turn out? Do you think it is much of a fight? If we as Christians know how the story ends, how should that motivate us in our lives today?

## Revelation 21

If you have any gold or precious stones in the house, take them out to look at them. Talk about how amazing it will be to see the New Jerusalem with walls covered in precious stones and the streets covered in gold.

### Questions

1. What happens to the original heaven and earth? What is then created?
2. What are some of the things to look forward to in the new heaven and earth? Which one are you looking forward to the most?
3. Describe the Lamb's wife or bride.
4. Why is there no temple or light in New Jerusalem? Do you want to go there someday? Why or why not?

## Revelation 22

Turn all the lights on in the house (just for fun). What will it be like to never have any night?

### Questions

1. What comes out of the throne of God? What does it do?
2. What did John do that was wrong? Why do you think he did that? Can you imagine what the angels must look like?
3. What warning does God give? Are you careful with God's Word in this way?
4. What phrase is mentioned multiple times in this chapter? How might that be significant as the last chapter in the Bible?
