### *Consequences of Decisions (Achieve Results)*

We can assess our performance as leaders by the consequences of the decisions we make.

In general, do your decisions:

- Improve or worsen relationships?
- Give you and others focus or result in scattered efforts?
- Help you keep the big picture in mind or cause you to get bogged down in side issues?

In [Leviticus 26](#), God describes the consequences of making decisions that align with His Word compared to the consequences of not obeying His Word.

In what ways do the consequences of your decisions let you know how well you are listening to God?
